Continue practicing multiplication facts! We still do multiplication tests most Mondays. Hit the 3's and 4's hard so students can get to higher multiplication facts.

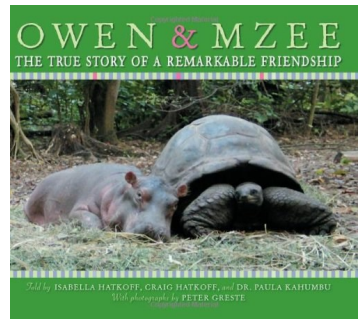

## READING AND WRITING

In reading, we are starting book clubs again. The students will read their books and we will discuss nonfiction text features and examples of cause and effect from the text. We will also be learning some amazing stories of migration as we read *The Journey—Stories of Migration*. Once we finish this book, the students will write a movie pitch for an adventure film based on what they learned about an animal's migration story.

In writing we are working on our animal research. The students will be researching and starting the rough draft. ***Please have your child draw a picture of his/her animal or print a picture out. Send those to school this week.***
