**Please practice multiplication facts at home.

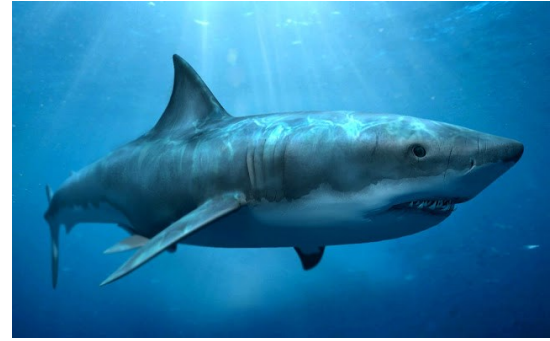
READING AND WRITING

Our next writing project will

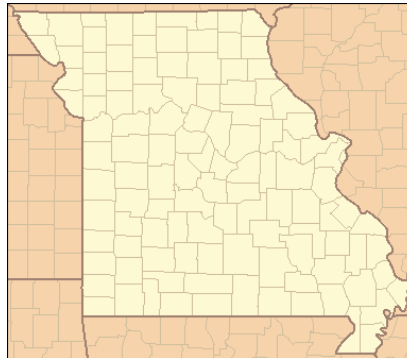
